Welcome

Sunshine State Homeschoolers (SSH) offers multiple online curriculum options because no single curriculum is the best fit for every learner. Home education families may choose the option that best matches their student's learning style, educational goals, and desired level of structure.

Parent Responsibilities

Provide daily educational supervision.
Grade written work when using a parent-directed curriculum option.
Maintain home education records and complete required reporting or evaluations.
Monitor student progress and course completion.

SSH Responsibilities

Coordinate curriculum access, initial course setup, or enrollment in the Fully Online Teacher-Supported Program.
Help families compare curriculum and course options.
Provide available provider progress and completion information.

Understanding Your Online Curriculum Options

SSH offers self-paced curriculum and fully online teacher-supported options so families can choose the level of structure, flexibility, course variety, and instructional support that best fits their student. Available options vary by grade level and selected program.

Edmentum

A comprehensive online curriculum emphasizing mastery-based learning, structured course progression, and individualized academic support.

Expanded Course Options may be added for additional electives, foundational support, advanced coursework, honors and Advanced Placement courses, career and technical education, and specialty subjects.

SSH Personalized Core Learning Package

Available for Kindergarten–Grade 5, this flexible package combines adaptive online instruction, educational enrichment resources, and printable grade-level workbooks. It is designed for families who want an affordable curriculum while remaining actively involved in daily instruction.

Fully Online Teacher-Supported Program

For families seeking a more structured online program, SSH offers fully online classes through EdOptions Academy. Certified teachers provide instructional support, grading, and academic feedback within the online program.

This option is available for grades K–12 at \$550 per month and may be used while the student remains in a home education, umbrella school, or private school program.

Choosing the Right Curriculum

Families should consider the student's grade level and academic needs, the amount of structure and independence needed, preferred learning format, desired electives or advanced courses, desired level of teacher support, budget, and long-term academic goals. SSH can provide consultation services to assist families with comparing available options and developing an appropriate course plan.

Kindergarten–5th Grade

Families may compare two self-paced elementary curriculum options and a fully online teacher-supported program.

Fully Online Teacher-Supported Program for Grades 6–8 — \$550 per month

Students complete structured online courses through EdOptions Academy with certified teacher support, grading, and academic feedback. This option is designed for families who want more direct teacher involvement while maintaining their existing homeschool, umbrella school, or private school enrollment.

Available subjects may include English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Health and Physical Education, World Languages, Career and Technical Education, and electives.

Optional Expanded Course Options

Families may add expanded course access when a student would benefit from additional electives, world-language study, advanced coursework, or targeted academic support. Expanded options are available for an additional fee and must be selected based on the student's grade level, readiness, and academic plan.

Edmentum Expanded Course Options

Advanced Coursework: May allow academically ready students to complete select high school-level courses, such as Algebra 1, when appropriate and approved as part of the student's academic plan.

Foundational Support and Remediation: Helps students strengthen reading, writing, mathematics, algebra-readiness, and science skills before or alongside grade-level coursework.

Additional Electives: Provides broader choices in technology, career exploration, business, health science, engineering, agriculture, family and consumer science, and other areas.

Teacher-Supported Option: Families seeking teacher-led instruction, grading, and academic support should select the Fully Online Teacher-Supported Program. Teacher services are not offered as individual course add-ons to the parent-directed curriculum options.

Eligibility depends on the official course code, course level, sequence, laboratory component, graduation year, and current program requirements. An asterisk does not mean the course is required for every home education student.

Optional Expanded Course Options

Families may add expanded course access when a student would benefit from additional electives, honors or Advanced Placement coursework, career and technical education, certification-preparation courses, or targeted academic support. Expanded options are available for an additional annual fee and are selected based on grade level, prerequisites, readiness, graduation plan, and postsecondary goals.

Edmentum Expanded Course Options

Honors and Advanced Placement: Includes select honors and AP courses for academically prepared students who meet applicable prerequisites.

Foundational Support and Remediation: Includes readiness courses in English, mathematics, algebra, science, and study skills.

Career and Technical Education: Provides broader options across business, information technology, health science, engineering, agriculture, law and public safety, hospitality, human services, skilled trades, and other options.

Additional Electives: Adds fine arts, social science, technology, college-readiness, and specialty electives.

Teacher-Supported Option

Families seeking teacher-led instruction, grading, academic feedback, and ongoing teacher support should select the Fully Online Teacher-Supported Program.

Teacher services are not offered as individual course add-ons to the parent-directed curriculum options.
